What would you do with these? How would you make sure they  
were spread around?

What do you think would happen if the seeds never grew? Do  
you think we should help the seeds grow? Should seeds travel to  
different places? Why?

Do you think the seeds are a good design? Is their method of  
dispersal effective?

What does the seed need to ensure it will be dispersed  
effectively? If you were going to improve the seed what would you  
do? How would you change the seed if there were no wind or birds  
or water to help with dispersal?
